Words from Pastor Bryant

Dear Disciples,

When was the last time you were genuinely surprised? And by surprised I mean jump out of your seat, heart pounding in your chest, a yelp emanating from your voice kind of surprise.

This jolting surprise happened to me the other day. I had been sitting in my living room—my mind drifting between listening to the TV, daydreaming about warm weather, and watching my kids out of the corner of my eye.

I must have missed it—the sound of a child trying to get my attention apparently went in one ear and out the other without comprehending what they said—but, in either case I missed what my kid was saying: "Catch!"

Catch. Again, my mind was floating off when it dawned on me milliseconds too late that I was being told to catch a ball from a child who was actively throwing said ball without making sure I had truly heard them.

My mind had no choice but to be jolted from daydreaming and back into realty as a ball struck me across the cheek, I haplessly swatted at it far too late, jumped up, and let out an *ouch!* as I looked to uncover what had just happened.

Needless to say, I was surprised. But, why? A voice had clearly called out to me saying, "Catch!" If I had simply looked, I would have seen a ball held in a hand ready to be thrown in my direction. If I had simply used a couple of my senses there wouldn't have been a surprise at all—I would've been fully prepared to have a ball thrown in my direction and catch it out of the air.

Sometimes even when all the information we need is right in front of us, we're still surprised. When the women journey to the tomb on the first Easter morning, we're told they're filled with excitement, fear, and amazement—we're told they're surprised.

May we forever be amazed and surprised at what Jesus is up to in our lives and in the life of the world. May we always be on the lookout for the unexpected places and people Jesus shows up through. May we always be surprised and embrace Jesus' incredible and abundant new and everlasting life that sustains us in this incredible journey that we call life.
