Words from Pastor Bryant

Dear Disciples,

As I write this, it rained last night. Notable, to be sure, as the sound of rain drops pelting the roof and wind rustling through the trees from a storm blowing through is a barely recognizable sound these days.

I've tried in vain to keep my yard alive this summer. As winter turned to spring I laid down some weed killer and fertilizer in the hopes that this year would be the year a lush, green yard would be mine. I'm here to tell you that this *isn't* that year.

Brown and bare are patches of yard. Spots that have either had grass die off completely or have turned dormant for the year in hopes that when they return next spring things will be better. It seems like all hope is lost—the thing I've been trying to keep alive is dead.

Now, there is something green growing in its place: Clover. Something I never planted or wanted. Something I haven't spent an ounce of water or minute of time tending or caring for and yet there it is. *Everywhere*.

Springing forth in ways I couldn't make the grass do if I tried. And so, as I sit back and watch my grass brown and the clover green and grow my attention has been caught by the creatures now invading my yard: Bunnies.

Hopping. Congregating. *Feasting*. Bunnies that are wide-eyed at the smorgasbord before them: clover as far as their little eyes can see. I did everything in my power to grow grass this year and it seems like as that grew instead was clover.

Clover that now feeds the neighborhood rabbits. An unintended result that is perhaps even better than the hoped for result. So it can be with faith. Prayer. *Life*.

How often do we pray for a certain result, hope for a particular outcome, work toward a specific goal only to have the fruits of our labors seemingly fall short. It's in those moments—the ones where we feel defeated—where the Holy Spirit picks up where we left off.

The Spirit says, "Thanks to your gifts and skills and the willingness to put them to use, the ordinary has become extraordinary." Not always in ways we expect, but always in ways that bring about newness of life.

Be on the lookout for the clover in your life. It might not be what you expected to show up, but it's exactly what is needed. Together, we plant the seeds of hope, faith, and love and thanks to Jesus Christ, they grow in mysterious and wonderous ways!


