

Words from Pastor Bryant

Dear disciples,

Vacation Bible School just wrapped up. What a wonderful week both kids and adults had learning more about how Jesus has called them by name—all through the incredible backdrop of the places and animals of Australia!

VBS can be a jarring experience—a mismash of people and places. For example, each day begins with an opening where the kids hear the theme song, watch a skit, and learn about the memory verse for the day.

This all happens in the sanctuary before the rest of the day's events take place in the Parish Center. However, before the opening begins, kids slowly begin to gather for the day as they're dropped off by their loved ones. And, as they're dropped off, the kids slowly begin to find their friends, chit-chat, and then they do what kids do when they're in a new, wide open space: they explore it.

And they explore it not nicely and quietly, but loudly and quickly. And the space they're exploring during those few minutes before the opening begins? The sanctuary. A place built nearly 160 years ago. A space that has witnessed countless worship services, baptisms, weddings, and funerals.

A space that, for most of the week sits quiet. A space that, even when filled with adults, is filled with quiet reverence, prayer, and song. Which is why during those few minutes each morning before VBS starts and kids are slowly gathering, it can be jarring to see a place and space filled with kids running, laughing, and talking—and yet, still learning more about Jesus—just like on Sunday mornings.

It is an incredible reminder that Jesus goes with us wherever we go. That in both the sacred and in the mundane, Jesus is with us. That in the holy and in the secular, Jesus' voice calls out to us. What a joy it was to journey with kids as they learned about Jesus' calling in their lives and his love for him—no matter the space or the place.

And what a joy it is for us: to be surprised daily by where Jesus shows up and who he speaks to us through. For often, Jesus will be where we least expect to hear him, see him, and find him —but, always, he is with us.

Calling us and claiming us as his own.
