**Card Ministry Team** is here for anyone in need of Christ's love through a card. The ladies of the card ministry are here because you all are important to us.

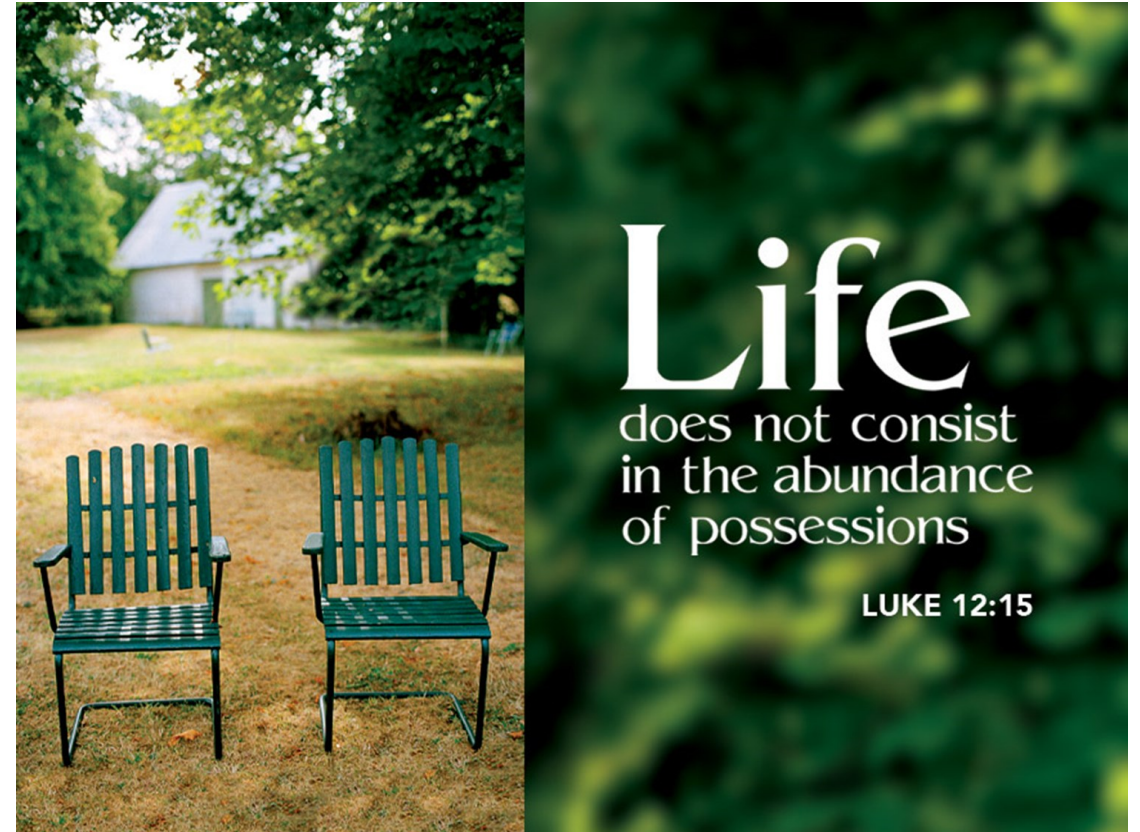
