CHURCH COUNCIL UPDATES

April 2021 Meeting:

The remaining agenda from the annual meeting remains tabled at this time.

Church council is sad to announce the resignation of Charlotte Sandeen as our Youth Director. Charlotte has served in this role for many years and has done a wonderful job planning and driving participation in EULC youth programs. She will be dearly missed.

Plans for the youth director position have not been established at this time. If there are any willing members, please reach out to a member of the church council.

Coordination of the plant sale is being handled by team/committee from past events chaired by Lori Scott. Budgeted amount is OK. Scheduling for Mother's Day Saturday and expecting proceeds will be left in the general fund due to a considerable number of investments to the church property that were planned and approved in the church budget.

A discussion was held regarding our COVID-19 plans as our current church service plans ran through Easter. 41% of Minnesotan's have received vaccine #1 and climbing, mask wearing is required and common practice, and it is expected that attendees will socially distance on their own since this has become a public standard. No contact tracing or registration is going to be conducted. Indoor services have begun under this mindset as of Sunday 4/18 and committees and leadership will monitor and adjust if needed. This is the first step towards regular operating procedures. There are likely to be some outdoor services as warmer weather returns. Feel free to contact the worship and music committee with any feedback as they work to restore other service needs and tasks as we move forward.  - All fluorescent lights are updated in the parish center except the high ceiling areas

New Business

- A request was submitted to re-establish the fellowship hour. Likely just coffee to begin. Starting June 6th. Signups will need to be coordinated.
- A newsletter mailing will be coming. A calendar of events will be included in a future mailing.
- Memorial Day honor guard will be present again at 7:30 am!
- Jeri Bowers has resigned from council. Vonda Gulden was the
 other candidate from the ballot at the annual meeting in
 January. Paul will reach out to her to see if she will fill in for Jeri for
 the remaining ~7 months of her term. Will announce this in a
 future newsletter once we confirm who is taking the spot.
- Restoration funds have been arriving. Paul and Gary both have letters and money to add to the fund. The property committee will use these funds for improvements at the church. Will follow up next month when Barb is present to see how we can establish a line item in our bookkeeping system to hold the balance until they are used.

Old Business

 - o Council will establish terms next month for current councilors for church approval as there has been some churn that may result in uneven terms.
