Words from Pastor Bryant

Dear Disciples,

Spring has sprung! *Finally*. As it stands now, my grass is green and slowly inching its way toward the sky which makes me realize I'll soon need to swap out the snow blower for the lawn mower — and quite possibly use the latter while wearing gloves and a coat.

Trees are slowly budding and tulips are popping out of the ground. Warmer weather is slowly but surely inching its way here. Birds are singing their songs and I can't help but notice the sun rising earlier and setting later with each passing day.

Hallelujah! And with spring entering our lives, I've been able to venture outside — outside where my backyard is framed in on all sides with a fence. A fence that keeps dogs (and children) within the bounds of my yard so they don't venture too far off on their own.

That fence reminds me of the Gospel reading we heard recently: That Jesus is the gate. It's an odd image to be sure, but Jesus as the gate provides us with a unique theological understanding of salvation.

Because gates are usually part of a larger fence system which itself is typically used for two purposes: To keep things in and to keep things out. Typically animals, but no matter the use, a fence provides a barrier between the inside and the outside.

And then a fenced-in enclosure usually has a gate. A gate that when closed provides protection and safety. But, a gate can also be opened. Opened so that passage between the inside and outside is possible.

Jesus as the gate provides protection and safety. Jesus as the closed gate saves us from the powers of death and sin. But, Jesus as the *open* gate allows us to venture out into the world. Jesus as the open gate is not salvation from something, but rather salvation *for* something.

Salvation to be freed and to free others. Salvation for the sake of our neighbors — so that with our shepherd leading the way, we are able to venture out and proclaim Jesus' light and love and life to all people.

New life is here! Together, let's venture out into God's creation with our Shepherd, Jesus, leading the way. Because when we venture through the gate we will find we've been saved from sin and saved for the good of our neighbors!
