Words from Pastor Sarah

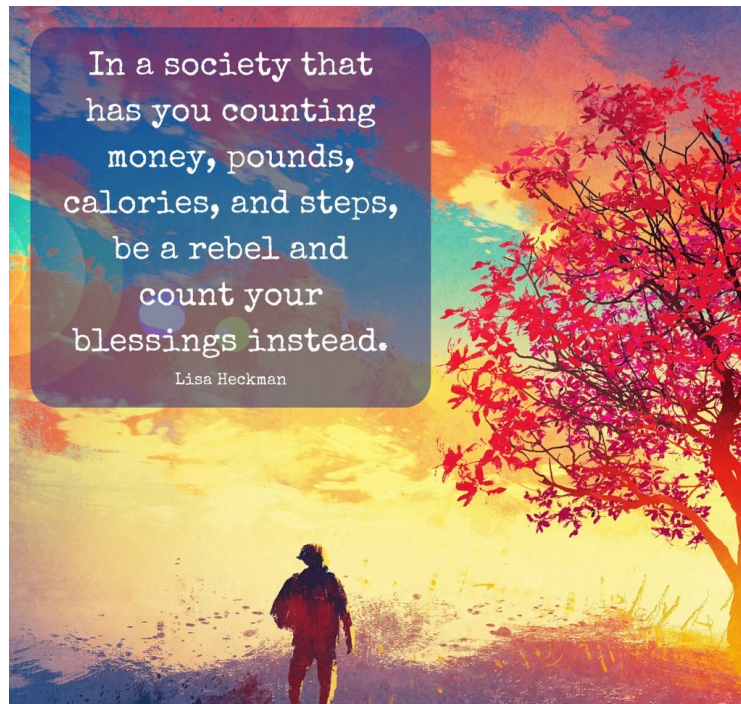

Pumpkin Cobbler Made by Carrie Hron

1 can (30 oz.) pumpkin pie mix.

1 can (12 oz.) evaporated milk.

1 c brown sugar

4 eggs

1 tsp. cinnamon

1 tsp ground cloves

1 box white or yellow cake mix (I have only tried yellow)

1&1/2 sticks of melted butter

Optional chopped pecan for the top.

1 to 2 tsp. vanilla optional.

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Mix pumpkin pie mix, milk, sugar, eggs, cinnamon and cloves together. Pour into 9"x13" pan or 8 7-oz. ramekins. Sprinkle dry cake mix on top, then drizzle with melted butter. Bake for 1 hour if using a pan, 40 mins. For ramekins. During the last 10 minutes of baking, sprinkle top with chopped nuts if desired. Enjoy!
