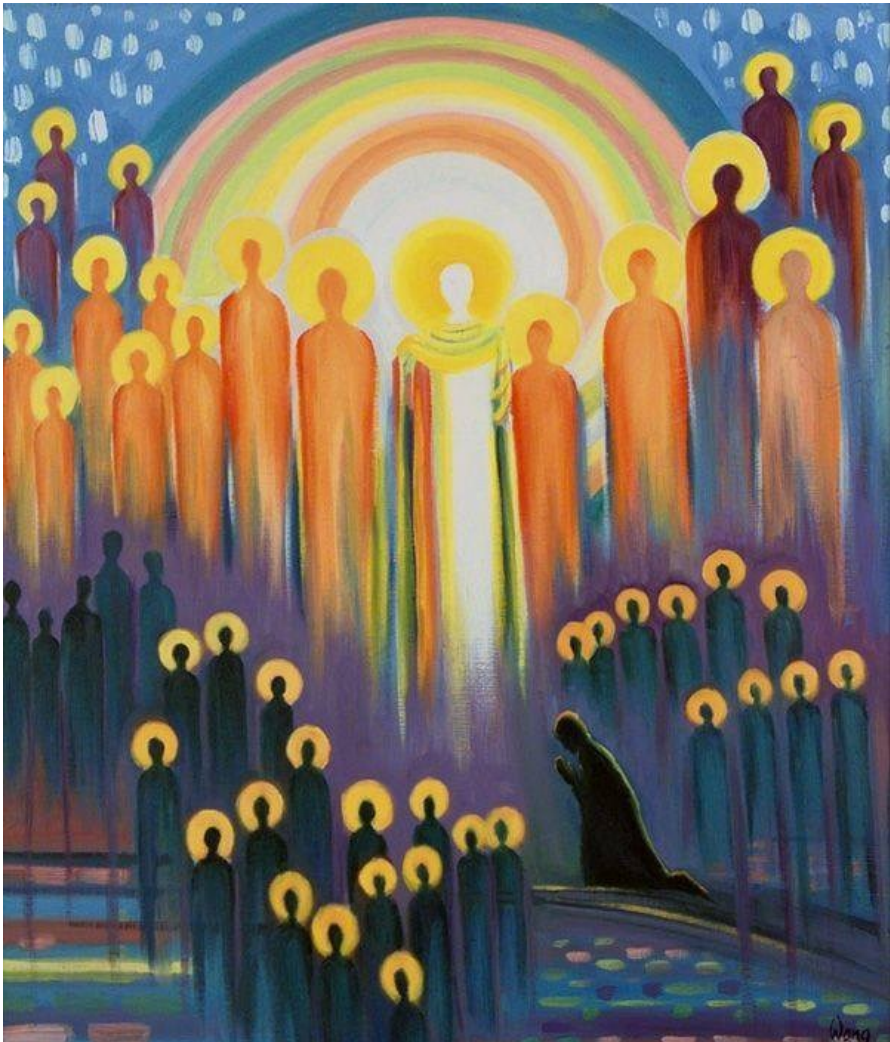

First Reading: Daniel 7:1-3, 15-18

The book of Daniel was written in the second century BCE, when the Syrian king Antiochus Epiphanes was severely persecuting the Jews. Daniel’s vision of the four beasts proclaims that human kings will come and go, but the kingdom will ultimately belong to God and to God’s people.

Psalm 149

Hallelujah! Sing to the Lord a new song, God’s praise in the assembly of the faithful. **Let Israel rejoice in their maker; let the children of Zion be joyful in their ruler.** Let them praise their maker’s name with dancing; let them sing praise with tambourine and harp.

The Lord takes pleasure in the people and adorns the poor with victory. Let the faithful rejoice in triumph; let them sing for joy on their beds. Let the praises of God be in their throat and a two-edged sword in their hand.
