FROM YOUR COUNCIL PRESIDENT

Thank you to everyone who completed the recent member survey. We mailed or emailed 166 surveys the week of September 1, 2020. While not a scientific survey, the data collected gives us a sense of how members feel about attending an inside Church service.

We received 46 completed surveys. If we assume the two person and family households submitted only one survey, we estimate the 45 responses represent 75 individuals.

Using the above numbers,
40 members indicated they would attend an inside service (with all the restrictions and conditions).

30 members indicated they would not attend an inside service.
6 members were unsure about attending an inside service.

This information will help provide your Church Council guidance as they continue to discuss and pray about how and when we will be able to gather for an inside Church service once again.
