SO... YOU THINK YOU'RE CALLED?

Understanding the call of God will introduce you to the administration of the Holy Spirit and the operation of His power in your life. Divine instruction is needed to identify the area of your specific calling. Then, believers can fully answer the call and have revelation of where they fit in the kingdom of God.

I. Understanding The Call Of God

- A. Matthew 22:14 "For many are called, but few are chosen."
- **B. Ephesians 4:11-12 -** "And he gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers; For the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ:"
- **C. 1 Corinthians 12:28 -** "And God hath set some in the church, first apostles, secondarily prophets, thirdly teachers, after that miracles, then gifts of healings, helps, governments, diversities of tongues."

When Considering The Callings Of God, Focus On The Function Of The Role With Less Emphasis On The Title Of The Position

II. Called Or Chosen... Which Are You?

Each person is called for a certain purpose, but have you accepted your call and allowed God to prove your calling to become appointed of God!

1 Corinthians 12:18

"But now hath God set the members every one of them in the body, as it hath pleased him"

God is the one who sets you in position. He is the one who knows who you are designed to be. Have you accepted the call? Have you gone through the process for God to truly prove you and appoint you to the place he designed? Only The Father Has The Answer To These Questions:

- Who am I?
- What is my call?
- What is my design?
- Where am I to be positioned?
- Am I called or chosen?
- Where am I in the process?

Our Discovery Should Be To Seek The Face Of God to identify who He created us to be.

III. The Process

The "process" is the longest part of the call to the final point of being proved and chosen of God. It is a key step in spiritual growth that many in the body of Christ miss. You can accept the call, say you are chosen, take the title, but the function of who you are is developed through the Process.

Joseph was called, but he had to endure the Process:

Being sold by his brothers, Put in jail for a crime he did not commit, Falsely accused of assault and many more tests during his process. Eventually, Joseph arises to a place of rulership because he went through the process.

Genesis chapters 37-40

IV. Approved & Appointed of God

Moses was born at a time that a decree went out that all Hebrew boys should be killed. Moses' life was spared by God and he grew up in the house of Pharoah. Why would God allow his servant to endure such experiences? Moses had an anointing to be a deliverer. He was destined by God to shepherd the flock. Moses was given specific instructions from God about his call to lead the children of Israel out of Egypt.

Moses lived 80 years before he stepped into his Appointment:

FIRST 40 YEARS - Moses learned Administration, Governance and the Structure of a Nation

<u>NEXT 40 YEARS</u> - Moses learned Shepherding and How to Care for the Flock
