I would love to play the violin really well. I took a class in high school, but never really stuck with it. It's my favorite instrument--I just think it's so beautiful.

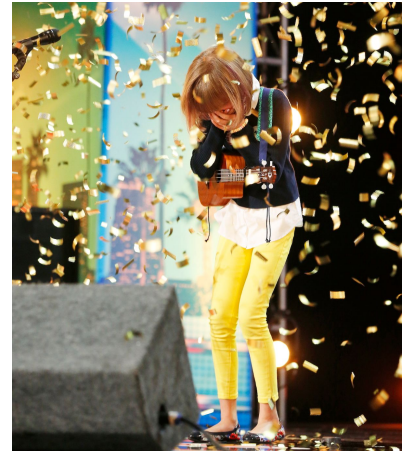
The Golden Victory of Vanderwall

3. Assassin's creed (PG-13) (Release date-December 21, 2016)



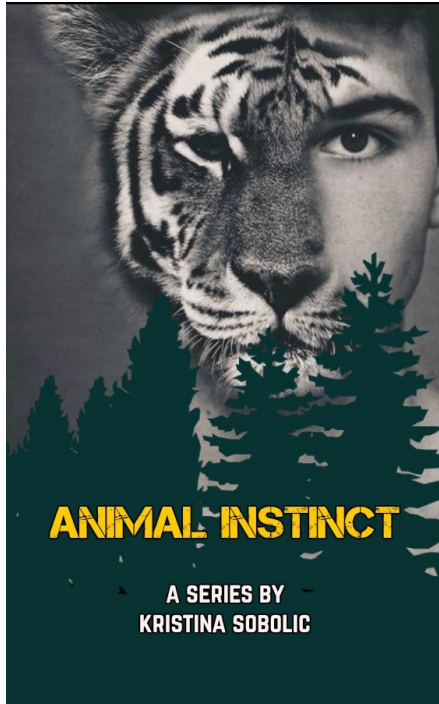

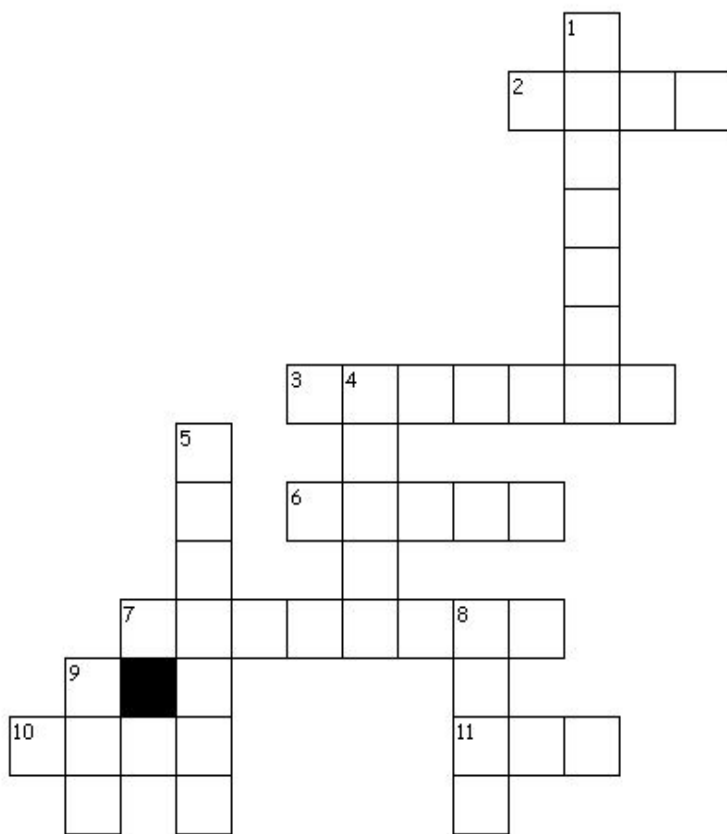
