## **Goodness – Part Seven**

<u>Galatians 5:22-23 (NLT)</u> <sup>22</sup> But when the Holy Spirit controls our lives, he will produce this kind of fruit in us: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, <sup>23</sup> gentleness, and self-control. Here there is no conflict with the law.

## **Ancient Philosophies Concerning Goodness**

**HAPPINESS:** Good is the experience of pleasure and the eradication of pain.

**EDUCATION:** Good is the acquisition of knowledge and the eradication of ignorance.

**DEMOCRACY:** Good is the greatest benefit for the greatest number.

MATERIALISM: Good is having goods!

• Each of these philosophies shares a common error – the idea that man on his own can choose **what is good for him!** 

The Bible teaches that people are not born good, but with a **sin nature.** 

<u>Psalm 51:5</u> Behold, I was shapen in iniquity; and in sin did my mother conceive me.

• The Bible teaches that each person ultimately **chooses** their behavior, and bears the consequences!

**Romans 6:16 (NLT)** Don't you realize that whatever you choose to obey becomes your master? You can choose sin, which leads to death, or you can choose to obey God and receive his approval.

• The Bible teaches us that we have no **power** in ourselves to choose the right behavior, even if we want to!

Romans 7:18-19 (NLT) <sup>18</sup> I know I am rotten through and through so far as my old sinful nature is concerned. No matter which way I turn, I can't make myself do right. I want to, but I can't. <sup>19</sup> When I want to do good, I don't. And when I try not to do wrong, I do it anyway.

Mark 10:17-18 <sup>17</sup>And when he was gone forth into the way, there came one running, and kneeled to him, and asked him, Good Master, what shall I do that I may inherit eternal life? <sup>18</sup>And Jesus said unto him, Why callest thou me good? there is none good but one, that is, God.

We don't "get good to get God," we "get God to get good!"

**The Greek word for "goodness" is the word "agathosune."** It is a rare word that combines BEING good and DOING good. It means goodness that originates in our heart but manifests itself in our actions. It literally means, "to be godlike."

- Our most accurate modern word for "goodness" would be the word "wholeness," or
- " INTEGRITY."
- INTEGRITY is a decision to integrate my heart's values into my daily living.

<u>Proverbs 28:6</u> Better is the poor who walks in his integrity than one perverse in his ways, though he be rich.

<u>1 Chronicles 29:17a (NLT)</u> I know, my God, that you examine our hearts and rejoice when you find integrity there.

<u>Matthew 6:1 (NLT)</u> Take care! Don't do your good deeds publicly, to be admired, because then you will lose the reward from your Father in heaven.

**1 Samuel 16:7b (NLT)** People judge by outward appearance, but the Lord looks at a person's thoughts and intentions.

**Romans 12:9 (CEV)** Be sincere in your love for others. Hate everything that is evil and hold tight to everything that is good.

**Romans 12:21 (NKJV)** Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good.

The only way you can beat the devil is to be the same in **private** as you are in public.
