- ➤ Ultrasound Initiative Form 10715 (Diocesan Evaluation) and Form 10716 (Application) required.
- >PRC Support/ASAP.

Special Olympics:

- Councils should fundraise, support and participate in local competitions.
- >Reporting is done exclusively online; must use Form #10784.





ASAP

For every \$500 a council donates to a qualifying PRC or Maternity Home, Supreme will match with \$100, up to \$2,000 total.
