  - Membership Intake—McGivney Award
  - Safe Environment Compliant
- Every parish have a Knights of Columbus presence
  - Councils or Round Tables
- Every Council has a Faith Formation component
  - Cor or other parish program for men
- Every Council meet State Charities Fundraising Goals



## FY 2023-2024 Results as of 6-26-24

- 331 Active Councils, 36 Suspended
  - 5 Active Councils under State Suspension
- 174 Councils at 100% of membership goals; 30 Active Councils at 0%
- 170 Councils have completed FBE requirements
- 158 Councils have approved Form SP7s
- 205 Councils are fully Safe-Environment compliant
- 112 Councils full qualified for Star Council
- 43 Districts qualified for Star District; 5 are qualified for All-Star District

**BOTTOM LINE: 200 or more Star Councils are possible**



# State Charities Fundraising Goals

- Council Goals for State Charities Funds in Florida K of C Charities
  - Vocations \$12 per member to State Vocations Fund
    - RSVP Does not Count!
  - Helping Life \$8 per member
    - \$4 per member must go to the State Helping Life Fund
    - Ultrasound & ASAP Project Funding does not count
  - Special Olympics \$4 per member
    - Directly to Special Olympics of Florida or to the State Special Olympics Fund
- Based on June 1 Membership Numbers
- Combination of Individual Donations and Council Fundraisers/Donations
- State Charities Awards will be tied to these goals
