

- Meet members where they want to be met
 - · We are all on a different path/schedule
- Provide multiple opportunities for members to engage in Council activities
- Communication is key





- Provide ample lead time when announcing project opportunities
- Provide clear vision of why activity is sponsored
- Define available roles for men to assist
- Have 'jobs" available for different skills and abilities





- · Ask men to bring a friend
- Offer training for volunteers
 - 1 on 1 shadowing
 - Quick pre-event meeting
- Keep men rotating to avoid burnout
- · Work as "teams"





- Be open to new ideas men bring forward
 - There will be more passion as men see new ideas being implanted
- · Understand members' motivation
 - · Why did they join?
 - Match volunteer opportunities to their skills and passion





- Thank volunteers Show gratitude
 - Knight of the Month award
 - · Family of the Month award
 - · Special awards for specific events
 - Acknowledge their contribution at meetings and in Council communications
 - Include them in articles/photos the council submits to the "Invocation" (FSC newsletter)

Round Tables – Why?

• "To actively engage Knights of Columbus members in order to aid the parish and sustain visible Catholic action through works of charity in every parish and mission throughout the Order, and in sustainable parishes to form the round table into a fully functioning council."

(#10506 Council Development and Retention Guidelines p13)





Round Tables – Why?

- Establish KofC presence
- Provide service to the parish
- Fill needs for ethnic development
- May be the best first step for parishes with less than 150 families





Round Tables - How?

- Grand Knight
 - Meets with priest
 - Appoints a RT Coordinator
 - Notifies Field Agent
 - Notifies potential RT members
 - Completes "Report of the Parish Round table Coordinator" form #2629
 - Sends form to Fraternal Mission Dept.
 - Copies to State Deputy, Regional Administrator, District Deputy, State RT Chairman, plus copy for Council files





Round Tables

- · There are no elected officers in a RT
- RT meets as necessary to aid their pastor and parish community
- RT has no dues, member dues are paid to hosting Council
- Council should provide assistance to RT members on larger projects
- Review annually with the pastor the effectiveness of the RT and the RT Coordinator


