## WHAT IS POLITICAL ACTIVITY? PARTISAN POLITICAL ACTIVITY VS ISSUE ADVOCACY

#### The Order DOES NOT Engage in Partisan Political Activity

Activity that promotes the election or defeat of a candidate for public office.

Activity that promotes the election or defeat of a political party.

#### **Examples**

- 1. Governor Smith is bad for Virginia and must be defeated.
  - 2. Senator Jones is pro-life and should be elected!
- 3. The Conservative Party of Canada must be defeated in the next election.





## WHAT IS POLITICAL ACTIVITY? PARTISAN POLITICAL ACTIVITY VS ISSUE ADVOCACY

#### The Order DOES ENGAGE in Issue Advocacy

Activity that promotes the enactment or defeat of a policy proposal or of legislation

#### **Examples**

- 1. I am pro-life and I encourage everyone to VOTE NO on Ohio Issue 1 because it would expand abortion in the Buckeye State.
- 2. Assisted suicide fails to recognize human dignity and should be rejected by all Canadians!
- 3. I am writing today as a pro-life American and in favor of H.R. 7, the No Taxpayer Funding for Abortion Act.
- 4. Organized involvement in national, state, provincial, and local marches for life (because they advocate a position on an issue).





#### WHEN TO GET INVOLVED?

- The Knights of Columbus is not an advocacy organization. However, we are an organization that is sometimes called to be advocates for our most deeply held beliefs.
- Issues are typically identified by the Supreme Council most notably those of international or national-level concern. State and provincial-level issues are also identified by Supreme.





#### WHEN TO GET INVOLVED?

- Not hearing from us on local matters does not mean there is not an important issue. If you see something, say something.
- If you, or a contact, identify an issue in your jurisdiction, check if the State Catholic Conference has a position (or other appropriate Church-affiliated entity). What activity have they taken?





# HOW TO GET INVOLVED Volunteer

- Most notable example is a state march for life.
- Catholic Conference may request volunteers for parish engagement
  - State Councils can share appropriate volunteer opportunities for members and their families.





#### HOW TO GET INVOLVED

#### **Share Information/Requests for Action**

- Great opportunity for your monthly newsletter or a special e-mail blast
- Letter from your bishop, or state conference of bishops,
   on an important matter.
- Letter from your bishop, or state conference of bishops,
   on an important matter.





#### RECAP OF ACTIONS TO TAKE

- A matter of public policy is identified for potential engagement.
- Consult how the State Catholic Conference, Church-aligned entity, and allied organization(s), have addressed the matter. Has the Supreme Council previously taken a position on a similar issue?
- Consider how the State Council might engage-dollars, volunteers, sharing information, sending out information.
- Contact the Supreme Advocate's Office and/or the Public Policy Office to discuss the matter and next steps.





#### GENERAL GUIDANCE

- Engage as a concerned citizen of your state or locality. Speak for yourself, not the Knights or as a Knight. Most powerful role is as a constituent.
- Of course, in their private capacities, Members are certainly free to engage in issue advocacy on matters which the Order does not take a position or provide for any recommended action.
- If a Member engages in partisan political activity, or in issue advocacy not endorsed by or within the scope of the Order's mission, Members MAY NOT WEAR the emblem of the Order.





#### MARCH FOR LIFE GUIDANCE

 Given the grave evil of abortion and its designation as a "preeminent issue" of social concern by the Church's leadership, the Order has supported marches for life for over half a century in countries where we are active.

• State and local councils, in addition to individual members, are encouraged to support local, state, provincial, and national marches for life as peaceful participants and volunteers.





#### MARCH FOR LIFE GUIDANCE

• Fraternal leaders should make use of official communication channels to help promote these marches.

 Council banners, KofC signage, and KofC apparel should be carried and worn proudly during march for life events.

• We do not provide security, but assisting marchers as volunteer marshals has long been a service provided by state and local councils.
