You may have noticed there are changes already happening in the underused Sunday school rooms and hallways. The nursery and Sunday school room for the “littles” have been relocated to the double room with purple doors which we used for council to meetings. The library has been cleaned out and is now able to be used as a conference room where council meets, and on Tuesday mornings Bible Study occurs. The grant committee has been seeking grants to cover the cost of replacing the roof. We have also had a contractor come look at making our restrooms ADA (American Disabilities Act) compliant. This would allow those with mobility restrictions to utilize the restrooms with ease. There are other ADA compliance upgrades being looked at to make the campus safe for all who use it.

Jenny Woods is working on an image we can use for social media that more appropriately represents who the congregation is today. No, we are not removing the cross Chris Janssen built and will continue to use that image for some things, just not all things. There will be a meeting held in a couple of weeks to vote on a new Mission Statement for this congregation. The current Mission Statement, "Making Christ Known" has served this congregation well for the past 40 years, but we are not who we once were. Today we work to create a space for all who enter this building to "Discover a Place to Belong". In doing this we facilitate an opportunity for Christ to be made known to those who do not have a relationship or may have a relationship in need of repair.

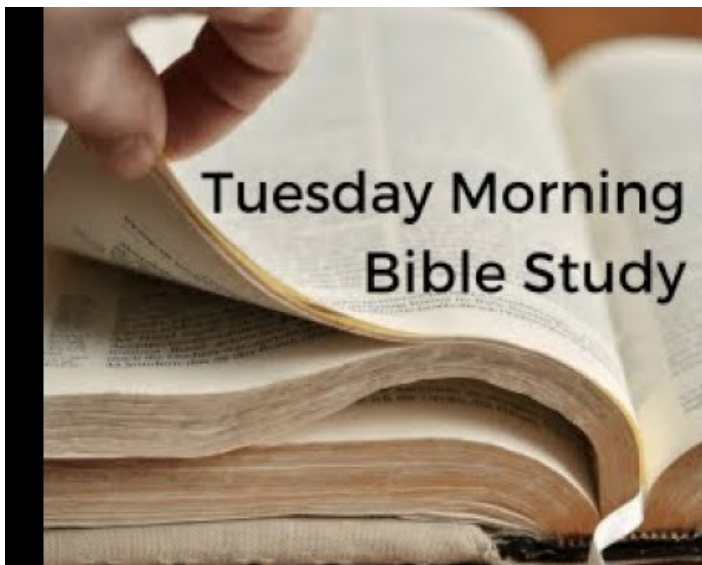
***Just One Item*** – breakfast cereal

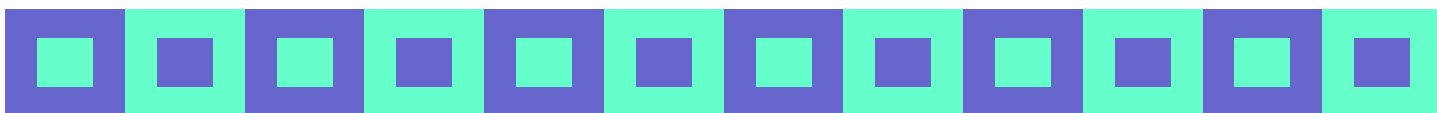
