South Carolina District and Supreme Fourth Degree Awards Program

The South Carolina District Fourth Degree Awards consists of five (5) district awards and three Supreme Awards. The five district awards are:

- Former Master Arthur E. Anderson (Sir Knight of the Year Award)
- Monsignor John L. Manning Catholicity Award (Youth)
- District "To Be A Patriot" Award (*Best Activity form #TBP-1*)
- Outstanding Assembly Award (Best Assembly Award)
- Catholic Legacy Award (New Sir Knight Recruitment)

There are also three Supreme Council Awards

- Supreme Council "To Be A Patriot" Award(Supreme Best Activity form #TBP-1)
- Supreme Council Civic Award (List Four Programs on form #2321)
- STAR Assembly Award

Former Master Arthur E. Anderson Sir Knight of the Year Award

<u>AWARD</u>: The FM Arthur E. Anderson Sir Knight of the Year Award is given annually by the District of South Carolina, Desoto Province of the Fourth Degree of the Knights of Columbus, in memory of FM Anderson. This award is given to an outstanding Sir Knight who best exemplifies those qualities which endeared Arthur Anderson to all who knew him. Arthur E. Anderson was the first Master of the South Carolina District. He was instrumental in revitalizing the Fourth Degree in South Carolina and establishing the District of South Carolina.

<u>REQUIREMENTS</u>: Each Assembly in the District of South Carolina shall nominate a Sir Knight in good standing who has enhanced the Fourth Degree in his Assembly during this Fraternal Year.

<u>NOMINATIONS</u>: The Assembly's nomination should do the nominee justice. Cover the nominee's works in his Assembly, parish, and community. The nomination package must be complete and comprehensive. He has worked hard for his Assembly and our Order, so make the nomination very strong.

<u>JUDGING</u>: The Master shall appoint a committee. The Master shall appoint a replacement in case of a conflict of interest by any member of the Selection Committee.

DISTRICT AWARD: PLAQUE – Awarded at the 2023 South Carolina State Convention.

MONSIGNOR JOHN L. MANNING CATHOLICITY AWARD

<u>PURPOSE</u>: The Monsignor John L. Manning Catholicity award is given annually by the District of South Carolina in memory of Monsignor John L. Manning. The award is given to an outstanding Catholic boy or girl who best exemplifies those qualities which endeared Monsignor Manning to all who knew him; Love of God, Love of Church, and Love of Country. In recognition of Monsignor Manning's many years as Rector of Bishop England High School and his dedication to the training of the youth of our diocese, the recipient shall be limited to a Catholic boy or girl who is enrolled as a full-time high school student in South Carolina.

<u>REQUIREMENTS</u>: The recipient must: 1. Be a baptized and practicing Catholic, 2. Be a full-time high school student enrolled in a Catholic, private, or public high school in South Carolina, and 3. Demonstrate their love of God, Church, and country by actively participating in the parish and living their Catholic Faith by service to their school and community.

<u>NOMINATIONS</u>: The nomination shall be written to justify the nominee for this award and signed by the Faithful Navigator. Letters and other documentation regarding the nominee's contributions to the church, school, and community should be included as part of the nomination.

It is recommended that the Assembly solicit nominees and gather supporting evidence for several nominees. Nominations shall be solicited from pastors and associate pastors within the various parishes, school officials, and other persons in the community who can attest to the nominee's activities.

<u>JUDGING</u>: The Master shall appoint a committee. The Master shall appoint a replacement in case of a conflict of interest by any member of the Selection Committee.

DISTRICT OF SOUTH CAROLINA FOURTH DEGREE TO BE A PATRIOT AWARD

<u>PURPOSE</u>: The District of South Carolina Fourth Degree "To Be a Patriot Award" will be given annually to the Assembly that conducts the best Patriotic Activities in their community during the Fraternal Year. The "To Be a Patriot" Awards Program aims to stimulate community interest in our great American Heritage, make them aware of our great country's story, and help spread patriotism through various activities.

<u>REQUIREMENTS</u>: Each Assembly is to select the single best patriotic project or activity the Assembly has conducted during the year. Each Assembly must submit documentation describing the activity, attesting to the program conducted, and addressing the judging criteria.

<u>NOMINATIONS</u>: Nominations must be submitted on Supreme Council's To Be A Patriot Form (form #TBP-1). The nomination shall be written to justify the activity for this award and signed by the Faithful Navigator. Programs, newspaper articles, pictures, and other documentation regarding patriotic community activities should be included as part of the nomination.

<u>JUDGING</u>: The Master shall appoint a committee. The Committee will make a recommendation to the District Master, who is responsible for the final decision. The Master shall appoint a replacement in case of a conflict of interest by any member of the Selection Committee.

- 1. The award is based upon a single patriotic project or activity conducted by an Assembly during the fraternal year.
- 2. BASIS FOR JUDGING
 - a. Does the program truly exemplify the virtue of patriotism?
 - b. How many members participated in the program? What percentage of the entire membership participated?
 - c. What were the benefits of the program? How did the results affect the community at large?
 - d. How original was the program?
 - e. How was the program publicized, and how effective was the publicity?

<u>DISTRICT AWARD</u>: PLAQUE – Awarded at the 2023 South Carolina State Convention.

NOTE** - Completing the form #TBP-1 and submitting it also makes the Assembly eligible to be submitted for the Supreme "To Be A Patriot Award," so only one TBP-1 form needs to be completed to be entered in the District and Supreme "To Be A Patriot Award" running.

"OUTSTANDING" ASSEMBLY AWARD

<u>PURPOSE</u>: The Award is to recognize those South Carolina District Assemblies that conduct "Outstanding" programs throughout the fraternal year and to recognize further the District's best Assembly based on submittals for the "Outstanding Assembly Award."

<u>REQUIREMENTS</u>: To be eligible, Assemblies must complete all requirements and submit the "Outstanding Assembly Award" application and supporting documentation to the District Program Director.

- 1. Hold unwaveringly to what is right and honorable, working to keep God in the civic arena by
 - Submitting the Civic Award (Form #2321)
- 2. Serve the life of the Church by
 - Provide at least five (5) Church related Honor Guards.
- 3. Defend laws that recognize the sanctity of life and true religious liberty by
 - participating in at least three (3) Pro-Life or Religious Liberty activities.
- 4. Honoring our legacy of Knighthood and celebrating our proud Catholic American History by
 - Sponsoring the exemplification of at least three (3) new members
 - Having at least 5 Assembly Sir Knights attending an Exemplification and banquet
 - Participation in the District Awards Program by
 - Nominating a "To Be A Patriot" event
 - Nominating a person for Arthur E. Anderson and/or Msgr. John L. Manning Award.

<u>JUDGING</u>: The Master shall appoint a committee. In the event of a conflict of interest by any member of the Selection Committee or the inability of a member to serve on the committee, the Master shall appoint a replacement.

<u>DISTRICT AWARD</u>: PLAQUE – Awarded at the 2023 South Carolina State Convention, or subsequent District Exemplification, if no Assembly qualified by the March 31st deadline.

All Assemblies that have met the requirements for the Outstanding Assembly Award will be recognized by the South Carolina District at the Assembly's officers' installation the following year.

CATHOLIC LEGACY AWARD

<u>PURPOSE</u>: We, as Catholic American Citizens, share a proud history. This history is best exemplified as part of the Fourth Degree Exemplification. The South Carolina District will present the Catholic Legacy Award to all Assemblies that share their Catholic Legacy by actively supporting exemplifications held by the South Carolina District.

<u>REQUIREMENTS</u>: To be eligible, an Assembly must actively recruit new Fourth Degree members, meeting their assigned quota during the fraternal year.

<u>JUDGING</u>: No judging is required. The SC District Master's records will serve as the account for the Assemblies.

<u>DISTRICT AWARD</u>: Assemblies will be recognized by the South Carolina District at the Assembly's officers' installation the following year.

SUPREME COUNCIL AWARDS

SUPREME COUNCIL "TO BE A PATRIOT" AWARD

<u>PURPOSE</u>: Established in 1985, the "To Be A Patriot" Award annually recognizes the three best patriotic programs conducted nationally by Fourth Degree Assemblies each fraternal year.

<u>REQUIREMENT</u>: Each Assembly will submit a report on their single best patriotic activity on form #TBP-1 to District Program Director to be judged as part of the South Carolina District "To Be A Patriot" Award.

- 1. The award is based upon a single patriotic project or activity conducted by an Assembly during the fraternal year.
- 2. BASIS FOR JUDGING
 - a. Does the program truly exemplify the virtue of patriotism?
 - b. How many members participated in the program? What percentage of the entire membership participated?
 - c. What were the benefits of the program? How did the results affect the community at large?
 - d. How original was the program?
 - e. How was the program publicized, and how effective was the publicity?

DUE: March 31, 2020

All #TBP-1 forms received by March 31, 2023, will be judged as part of the SC District "To Be A Patriot" Award. Noting that the Supreme Council website shows a May 31st deadline, any #TBP-1 forms received by the Master between March 31 and April 30, 2019, will be considered for the South Carolina District nomination for the Supreme Council "To Be A Patriot" Award.

JUDGING: The Master will judge the correctly submitted #TBP-1 forms and select a "To Be A Patriot" Award nominee, which shall be forwarded to the Vice Supreme Master of the De Soto Province. The Vice Supreme Master will select the best activity in the Province and submit the entry form to the Supreme Master. These entries will then be reviewed by a committee appointed by the Supreme Knight and Supreme Master.

Winners will be announced yearly in October. Once a program has been recognized as a winner at the international level, it cannot be entered into future competitions.

SUPREME COUNCIL CIVIC AWARD

<u>PURPOSE</u>: The Civic Award is presented annually as a tribute to the spirit of patriotism and national pride exemplified in the patriotic activities conducted by Fourth Degree Assemblies. Assemblies conducting a minimum of four different patriotic programs during the fraternal year are eligible for the Supreme Council Civic Award.

<u>REQUIREMENT</u>: To be eligible, Assemblies must complete and submit the Civic Award application to the Supreme Council office.

JUDGING: No judging. Just submit the Civic Award application.

<u>DUE</u>: June 30th. Note: This will only be accepted by Supreme if on time.

All Assemblies are encouraged to achieve Civic Award status every fraternal year.

THE STAR ASSEMBLY AWARD

<u>PURPOSE</u>: The STAR Assembly Award recognizes outstanding achievements in membership, programs, and overall excellence.
