

In my own name and on behalf of my fellow Supreme Officers and the Board of Directors, I extend greetings to you and the entire South Carolina jurisdiction.

Again this year, as a result of your diligent efforts and the selfless dedication of your brother Knights, the Knights of Columbus continues to grow, in furtherance of our principles of charity, unity, fraternity and patriotism. It was fitting that we gathered on February 22, the Feast of the Chair of Saint Peter, for it was in this same fraternal year that, through the charitable support of our Order, the Chair of Saint Peter and Saint Peter's *Baldacchino* were restored in Rome. For the Knights of Columbus, there is a deeper meaning in this project. These two masterworks commemorate not only the beauty of our Catholic tradition but symbolize the very unity of our Church — a unity at the foundation of our own identity as Knights.

Much has changed since Father McGivney issued his first call to unity in 1882. What remains constant is the necessity of his message: to be men of faith — men of charity, unity, fraternity and patriotism. Worthy State Deputy, I express my deep gratitude to you, your fellow state officers, district deputies, grand knights, council officers, general and field agents, and to every brother Knight in South Carolina.

May Our Lady of Guadalupe, Patroness of our Order, and Saint Joseph, Protector of the Holy Church, guide your deliberations. Blessed Michael McGivney, pray for us.

The South Carolina State Council welcomes Dr. Jonathan Reyes, Senior Advisor to the Supreme Knight and Senior Vice President for Strategic Partnerships, as our Supreme Guest to the 104<sup>th</sup> Annual South Carolina State Convention.

Dr. Reyes is the Senior Advisor to the Supreme Knight and Senior Vice President for Strategic Partnerships. He has also served as Senior Vice President for Communications and Senior Vice President for Evangelization and Faith Formation.

Prior to the Knights of Columbus Dr. Reyes served as Assistant General Secretary for Integral Human Development and executive director of the Department of Justice, Peace and Human Development at the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops.

He came to the role from his work as President and CEO of Catholic Charities in the Archdiocese of Denver. Dr. Reyes also founded Christ in the City, a national volunteer and formation program for college students dedicated to serving the homeless.

In 2005, Dr. Reyes also helped found the Augustine Institute of Denver, a graduate program devoted to Catholic Theological studies and leadership training, and served as its first president.

Dr. Reyes also spent several years as a Vice President for the Fellowship of Catholic University Students as well as the Vice President for Academic Affairs at Christendom College where he also served as a professor of history.

He studied European history as a Rackham Fellow at the University of Michigan, earning a PhD in European History at the University of Notre Dame.

He and his wife have seven children.

## REV. P.N. LYNCH COUNCIL #704

Our council is the first Knights of Columbus council in the two Carolinas. Our formation was in 1902. The following year, in 1903, the first class of new candidates was initiated on May 20<sup>th</sup> in Hibernian Hall. A total of 20 men became Knights. In 1906 the Council began construction on the present hall on Calhoun Street. Our namesake is the Most Reverend P.N. Lynch, Third Bishop of Charleston –1858 - 1882




