**Seventh District Master**  
**1974-1976**  
**(1913-1997)**

Matthew Joseph Oliver was born on March 25, 1913. A son of Emmanuel M. & Annie Gertrude Keegan Oliver. He grew up in Charleston and was a graduate of Bishop England High School. He married Lou Theresa Myatt and had one son, three grandsons and a great grandchild.

“Matty” was member of the Rev. P. N. Lynch Council #704 of Charleston and was a Past Grand Knight of the council. He was also a Past Faithful Navigator of the Rev. P. N. Lynch Assembly #1071. In 1974, he was appointed the seventh South Carolina 4th Degree District Master. He served one term from 1974-1976. He served as the 2<sup>nd</sup> District Degree Team Marshal for approximately 10 years.

Matthew Olliver was a communicant of St. Mary’s Catholic Church on Hassell Street in Charleston and was a member of the Holy Name Society. Those who knew Matt, called him the oldest Altar Boy in Charleston. He was always available to serve at mass. ‘

He worked for the US Post Office.

He died October 17, 1997.
