The certificate below must be completed and returned to the State Secretary prior to **March 8, 2024** in order for your delegates to be seated during the State Convention. Any changes made to the delegates or alternates must be known to the State Secretary prior to the opening of the business meeting so that the Credentials Committee may certify them.

Each local Council in good standing is entitled to two (2) delegates to the State Convention, namely the current Grand Knight and one Past Grand Knight. Councils should also elect two (2) alternate delegates. If the Grand Knight or a Past Grand Knight is not available, any third-degree Knight in good standing may serve as a delegate.

**Please Note:** Councils that owe per capita either to the State or Supreme or insurance fees are **not in good standing** and accordingly, their delegates will not be eligible to vote on any matters that come before the Convention. Therefore, please make certain that all per capita taxes and insurance fees billed to your Council have been paid, by checking with State Treasurer.

- Appropriate dress (Appendix C). Sir Knights must wear Color Corps regalia (preferred) or Social Baldric with Dark Suit or Tuxedo.

#### Requirements for attendance at meal.

- Assigned Seating according to Registration Records

#### All arrangements must be made through each Assembly. Required Assembly actions are as follows:

- Collect fees as appropriate from Candidates, Sir Knights and Guests
- Approve and complete Form 4 for each candidate (do not separate any parts from the Form 4; each Form 4 must be sent in complete in all its copies)
- Have each candidate sign the Required Dress Certification (Appendix C) and attach it to the candidate's Form 4.
- Complete list of candidates and guests (Appendix D)
- Make a single Assembly check to cover all fees, payable to **KofC SC State Council.**

Active duty and retired military, police, firefighters, and EMS personnel may wear their formal dress uniform instead of the Black (suit) Tuxedo. All questions concerning the wearing of a uniform should be addressed directly to either the District Master or the District Marshal. Candidates' fees include Social Baldric, 4<sup>th</sup> degree Lapel Pin, Supreme fees and one meal ticket. Additional meal tickets must be purchased through the Assembly.

In Addition: 1) There will be a collection at the Mass

2) Black face covering is required if not vaccinated
