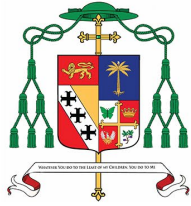

Bill joined the Knights of Columbus in July of 1997 at Mary Queen of Peace Council 9575 in Spartanburg, SC. He served as Grand Knight of Council 9575 from 2000-2002, earning Star Council in 2002.



Bill became a Sir Knight, joining Assembly 1655 in February of 1999. He served as Faithful Navigator from 2006-2007. In 2005, Bill was recognized as the Sir Knight of the Year for the District of South Carolina.

After serving as District Warden in the Spartanburg area for four years, Bill was appointed as District Deputy in 2008 by Supreme Knight Carl Anderson.
