Over a century ago, the vision of a Patriotic Degree ignited a movement among the Knights of Columbus. In 1899, the Supreme Knight appointed a committee to establish this new degree, and in just one year, enthusiasm spread so rapidly that on February 22, 1900, history was made.

On that day, 1,000 candidates stood together to be exemplified into the Fourth Degree. They were joined by a choir of 283 men and supported by 100 New York City Police Officers, bringing the total to 1,383 Brother Knights who became Sir Knights of the Fourth Degree. Imagine the magnitude of that moment, at a time when the population was much smaller, such a turnout was an incredible testament to the deep call of patriotism and faith. That same spirit endures in our Order today.

This ceremony takes place as we approach the 250th Anniversary of our nation. If you have not yet joined the Fourth Degree, we urge you to prayerfully answer the call to become a Sir Knight on March 28, 2026. This Exemplification will not only deepen your understanding of our principles of patriotism but will also reignite your call to civic duty.

We promise an experience that will inspire and enrich your faith. All necessary information is attached. After 125 years, families can witness this sacred tradition, hear the profound lessons of patriotism and civic responsibility, and celebrate the knighting of their fathers, husbands, and sons.

Join us as we continue the legacy of Faith, Patriotism, and Service.

- Third Degree Knight of Columbus with current membership card.

### Uniform Guidelines for Candidates/Sir Knights

The preferred attire for candidates is the current Fourth Degree uniform. An appropriate alternative is a dark suit with a conservative tie or a dress uniform for military members, law enforcement or firefighters without a firearm. It would be inappropriate for law enforcement officers to open carry a firearm at the Exemplification. Candidates may no longer wear a tuxedo for the exemplification. Social Baldrics are no longer issued to new Sir Knights, nor should the social baldric be worn with the official uniform, a suit, or any attire other than a tuxedo.

*Members admitted prior to June 30, 2024, may continue to use the social baldric when wearing a tuxedo. Tuxedo and social baldric for these Sir Knights are permitted at this event.*
