#### **HOPE COFFEE SHOP**

Our Hope Coffee Shop will serve coffee, tea, and a simple breakfast - Mondays through Saturdays from six until eleven each morning.

Our location is perfect for walking and driving customers. The shop will mainly serve take-outs, but will have a few seats.

#### **OUR VISION**

Our vision is that revenue generated will allow Hope Plaza to assist in providing:

- Assistance for Mission Initiatives.
- School Backpacks and Supplies for Community Students.
- Lunches for Community Seniors.
- Hygiene Kits for Crisis and Disaster Responses throughout the Islands.

#### **OUR NEED**

Our goal is have a soft opening January 2025. Our financial need to complete the Hope Coffee Shop is \$5,000 USD.





#### **HOPE HOME**

Commencing in January 2025 Jonathan and Shena plan on serving in The Bahamas the second week of each month, and working out of the Hope Plaza.

Jonathan has been appointed to the Executive Council of The Assemblies of God in The Bahamas Including the Turks and Caicos Islands, and his main roles are developing a Fellowship Crisis and Disaster Ministry and assisting with leadership development.

The Hope Home will save \$600 to \$1,000 in accommodation cost per month, and will also provide needed housing for visiting missionaries.

**Hope Home** is located at the rear of the plaza and allows for comfortable stay and easy access to the offices and training center.

# HOPE TRAINING CENTER Our center offers life-changing services.

 Hope Plaza Chaplaincy Services trains and deploys volunteer chaplains. Our chaplains serve throughout The Bahamas and The Dominican Republic as commissioned chaplains with Frontline Chaplains International. Jonathan Carey serves as the Caribbean Regional Commander for FCI.

 Hope Plaza Chaplaincy Services provides confidential coaching and counseling for first responders and their families. We assist them in developing a personal self-care model.

Hope Plaza Chaplaincy Services provides Critical Incident Stress Debriefing. CISD is a form of crisis intervention aimed at reducing the traumatic impact of an event by fostering a connection between people who went through the same experience, increasing effective coping, and trauma education after the stressful event.
