The Question—

- Logical Implication: • Such fine-tuning strongly suggests intentional design, rather than a series of cosmic accidents.



3. The Laws of Cause and Effect

- The Big Bang Theory suggests that the universe began from a single point and expanded outward.

After reading an air-tight case like that, some still choose to scoff at the existence of God. For those who admit there must be a Creator, you also know that one day you will die and have to face Him.

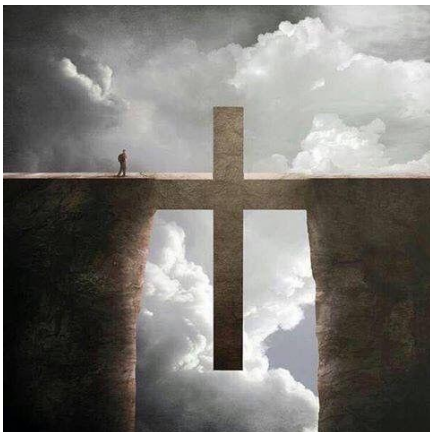

1— REPENT

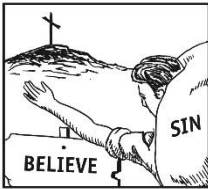
Agree with God.

The gospel, or “good news,” is the Death, Burial, and Resurrection of Jesus Christ.

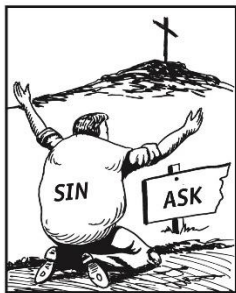
It is the process by which God removes our sins and gifts us His righteousness.
